Hi everyone,

There has been increasing media attention on nudity recently, with items ranging from censorship of nudity to the debate about breastfeeding in public. Another way to increase magazine subscriptions is to include it on your annual club levy invoice, as an optional item that can be opted out of.

MAGAZINE CHANGES - THANKS KAY HANNAM

The September 2015 issue of *gonatural* Magazine marked Kay Hannam's final, as editor of 35 editions

In January 2007 Kay was appointed as Editor of *gonatural* magazine following on from Conrad Inskip - who resigned for health reasons - and since then has fitted editing and publishing the magazine around running and growing Wai-natur Naturist Park in Marlborough.

gonatural Magazine began in 1956 as an eight page black and white quarterly publication. The first issue that Kay put together, with help, tips and advice from former editor Les Olsen and his wife Laurel, was a 24 page publication with four colour centre pages. Today the magazine has developed to 44 pages of full colour goodness, including a digital edition, and is almost entirely

dedicated to New Zealand naturism with regular contributors submitting interesting articles of their travels and experiences.

It is with much sadness that we must bid farewell to Kay as Managing Editor, but with enormous gratitude for her many years of incredible service

and contribution to the magazine and wider naturist community.

We have much appreciation also for the healthy state in which the magazine will be handed over to the new team which will manage, edit and publish it going forward.



MAGAZINE CHANGES - INTRODUCING NOEL THOMAS & MICHAEL MOORE

We are thrilled that the magazine can be transferred from one superstar into the hands of a team of enthusiastic professionals.

Noel Thomas takes on the role of Business Manager and provides production services as well as administrative and accounting services. Even with Kay, the Chair, being in Europe for two months and June being overseas for a month, work has continued at pace by the Planning Committee via email.

Kay recently met with INF President Sieglinde Ivo and INF Vice-President Secretariat Jean Peters in Lyon, France, to discuss planning progress and what the INF requirements and timeline are.

Kay reports that it was a productive meeting and that both Sieglinde and Jean are very happy with the progress being made by the Planning Committee and volunteers, and are confident that everything is pretty much under control.

Marketing via Facebook is going strong and a campaign has begun showcasing the 16 governmental regions of our country, from north to south, and the naturist accommodation and beaches that are available within each one. Some of the posts have

Tourism New Zealand are providing more "delegate funding" and 1/4 page adverts are being developed to place in the British, Canadian and Australian naturist magazines from late this year to mid next year. These are targeted at reaching the most potential delegates possible.

Secretary	 Notify all members of due dates for meetings, nominations and remits. Record mail movement and meeting business. Record and circulate minutes of Executive and Council meetings. Ensure the Constitution is updated each year after the AGM Ensure the Officers of the Federation are updated on the Societies website annually. Ensure all requests for affiliation to the Federation are dealt with at the next available meeting Liaise with the INF as required
Communications Officer	 Attend to media releases for events and promotion of naturism as opportunities arise. Respond to media and other enquiries for information. Maintain social media sites.
Database Secretary	 Process applications for INF cards. Record and distribute cards, in accordance with properly constituted requests from Member Clubs. Maintain the central database.
